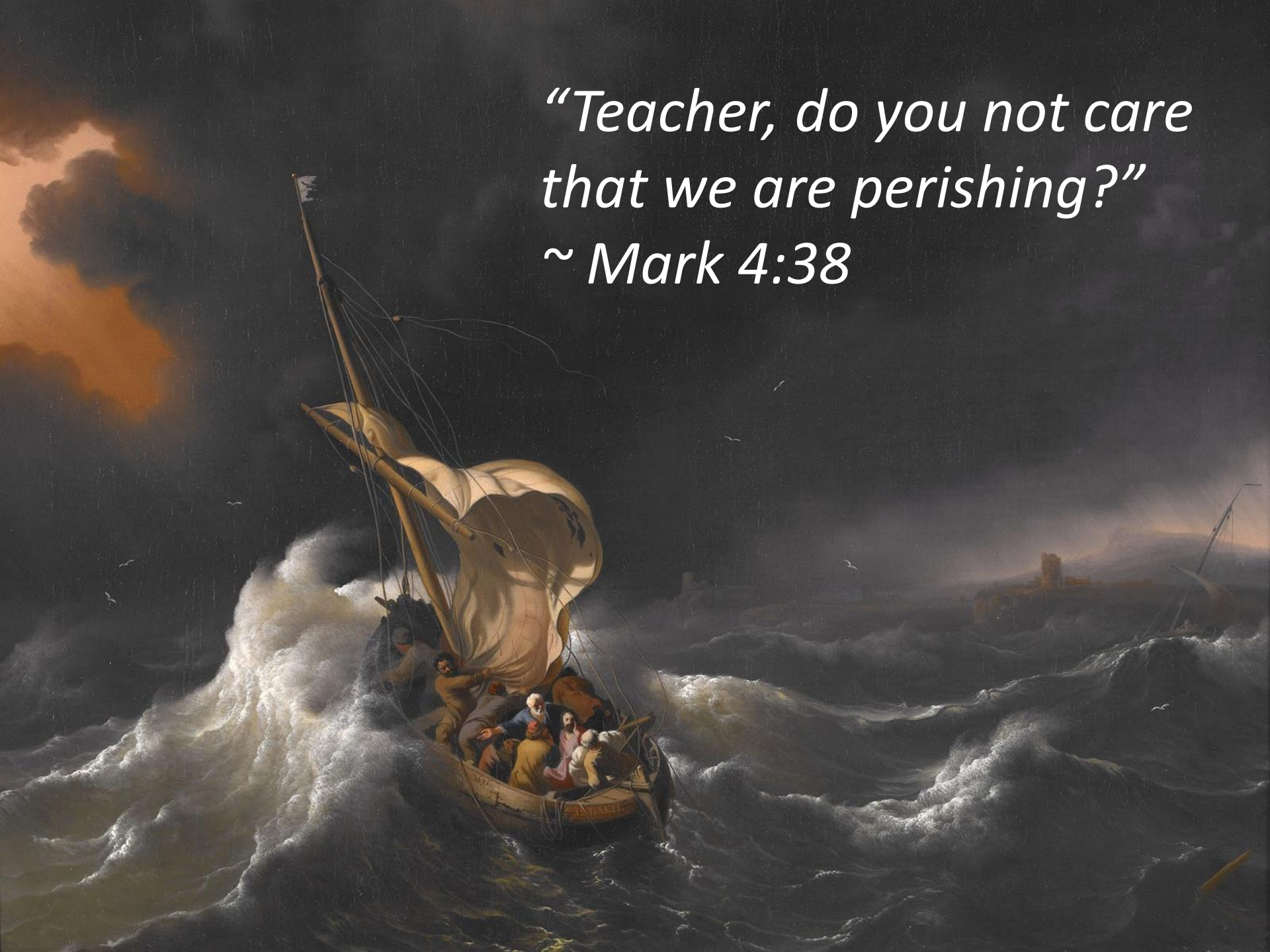




He wants to hear our anxieties - 1 Pe 5:7
